

Butler Township Fire Commission

July 18, 2018

The Butler Township Fire Commission held a meeting on Wednesday, July 18, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Butler Township Municipal Building, 290 South Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001.

The following members were in attendance: Primary Member Toby Wehr from Station No. 3; Primary Member Alan Paul from Station No. 6; Primary Member Karl Kobil from Station No. 7, Citizen Member Charles Savannah and Commissioner Jim Lokhaiser. Fire Marshal Chris Switala, Manager Ed Kirkwood and Asst. Manager Cheryl McNeill were also in attendance.

Fire Marshal Switala called the meeting to order with a moment of silence, followed by the Pledge to the Flag.

Motion by Karl Kobil to approve the minutes of the May 16, 2018 meeting, seconded by Alan Paul. The vote was Station 3: Yes; Station 6: Yes; Station 7: Yes; Lokhaiser: Yes. Savannah: Abstain. Motion carried.

There was no public comment on agenda items.

Purchases

Station No. 3 has no purchase requests.

Station No. 6 presented the request for approval to have concrete work done at their Victor Road Station. Multiple quotations were received. They presented a quote from Finke Concrete Construction in the amount of \$31,507.00. A discussion followed.

Motion by Toby Wehr to authorize the repairs to the Victor Road Station to be made by Finke Concrete Construction in the amount not to exceed \$31,507.00. Seconded by Commis. Lokhaiser. Questions were asked concerning the sanitary sewer line and the storm sewer line that were in the repair zone. Station No. 6 was advised to speak to the respective authorities concerning these lines. The vote was Station 3: Yes; Station 6: Yes; Station 7: Yes; Lokhaiser: Yes; Savannah: Yes. Motion carried.

Station No. 7 had no purchase requests.

New Business

Commissioner Lokhaiser requested that Station No. 7 participate in the National Night Out event to be held in the Township on Aspen Road on August 7th at 6:00 PM. Station No. 7 volunteered to send an engine to the event.

Commissioner Lokhaiser noted that this will be the last official meeting for Ed Kirkwood as Manager of Butler Township. He thanked Manager Kirkwood for his service to the Township.

Motion by Charles Savannah and seconded by Karl Kobil to adjourn the Fire Commission meeting at 6:50 p.m. and carried unanimously.
