

**MINUTES OF THE
REGULAR MEETING HELD
June 1, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Butler Township Board of Commissioners was held on June 1, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the Butler Township Municipal Building, 290 S. Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001. The following Commissioners were present: Pres. Dave Zarnick, Vice Pres. Sam Zurzolo, Commis. Joe Wiest, Commis. James Lokhaiser and Commis. Fred Vero.

Also present were Manager Tom Knights, Asst. Manager Cheryl McNeill, Township Engineer Dan Dieseroth, Dir. Of Public Works Dave Meeder, Chief John Hays and Solicitor Rebecca Black.

Pres. Zarnick stated that anyone taping the meeting is required to state their name; Ryan Saeler from Butler Radio Group indicated he would be taping the meeting.

Pres. Zarnick called for any corrections to the minutes of the prior meeting. There being none the minutes stood as approved.

Pres. Zarnick gave a statement thanking County and Township residents for their performance during the pandemic. Also gave voting information for the upcoming primary election.
