

**MINUTES OF THE
REGULAR MEETING HELD
July 6, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Butler Township Board of Commissioners was held on July 6, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the Butler Township Municipal Building, 290 S. Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001. The following Commissioners were present: Pres. Dave Zarnick, Vice Pres. Sam Zurzolo, Commis. James Lokhaiser and Commis. Fred Vero.

Pres. Zarnick stated that anyone taping the meeting is required to state their name; Ryan Saeler from Butler Radio Group indicated he would be taping the meeting.

Pres. Zarnick called for any corrections to the minutes of the June 24, 2020 Special meeting. Commis. Lokhaiser indicated Vice Pres. Zurzolo was not included as being present at the meeting in the minutes. With that correction the minutes stood as approved.

Pres. Zarnick gave a statement thanking County and Township residents for their performance during the pandemic. Also an update on the signage for McCalmont Road.

Manager Knights presented the recommendation to award the 2020 Road Paving Project contract to the low bidder from the June 15, 2020 bid opening Wiest Asphalt in the amount of \$284,847.92.

Motion by Comm. Lokhaiser to award Wiest Asphalt the 2020 Road Paving contract in the amount of \$284,847.92. Seconded by Comm. Vero. The vote was Lokhaiser: Yes; Vero: Yes; Zurzolo: Yes; Zarnick: Yes. Motion Carried

Manager Knights presented the recommendation to award the Preston Park Paving Project contract to the low bidder from the June 15, 2020 bid opening Wiest Asphalt in the amount of \$86,535.00.

Motion by Comm. Vero to award Wiest Asphalt the 2020 Preston Park Paving contract in the amount of \$86,535.00. Seconded by Comm. Lokhaiser. The vote was Lokhaiser: Yes; Vero: Yes; Zurzolo: Yes; Zarnick: Yes. Motion Carried

Manager Knights read correspondence from the Disabled American Veterans Chapter #64

Pres. Zarnick asked for public comment on any item of concern and there was no public comment.
