SUBJECT: Training Request

I am requesting permission to have Ptlm. Tyler Collins attend the Street Smart Cop / Pro-Active Patrol Tactics training being held at Shafton VFD located in North Huntingdon, PA. The training is scheduled on September 30 and October 1, 2019.

The course is designed to make a Police Officer CONFIDENT and PROFICIENT in their everyday duties while opening their eyes to Criminal and Narcotic Interdiction. The course teaches a police officer to detect a crime before, during and after the commission of a criminal offense. The training is more than "Drug Interdiction." It provides police officers the knowledge to do their job confidently and legally. Students learn better patrol tactics, identifying criminal behaviors and reactions to police presence, case law, search and seizure, drug trends and consent searches. Officers are shown legal and effective methods for conducting Re-Active and Pro-Active patrol functions. Training our officers with knowledge they should know will prevent embarrassment and lawsuits from misinterpretations of the law.

The cost of the course is \$199.00. A department vehicle will be provided and meals will be reimbursed.
