

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
BUTLER TOWNSHIP, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Butler Township Commission at the Municipal Building, 290 South Duffy Road, Butler, Pennsylvania 16001 until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time on June 1, 2020 for the following:

PRESTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS

Butler Township is Planning for the development and improvement of Preston Park, located along South Eberhart Road in Butler Township, Butler County. This project was financed in part by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

The project includes, but is not limited to: the construction of a one-way loop roadway, parking areas, site development for new restroom facility, gravel and concrete paved sidewalks, utilities, E&S controls, vegetated channels, sediment trap/bio-retention area, install new gate, tree removal and other improvements.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope that is clearly marked on the outside with the appropriate wording “**PRESTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS**” to the attention of Mr. Thomas Knights – Township Manager, Municipal Building, 290 South Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001 until 2:00 p.m. on June 1, 2020. The same will be publicly opened and read at the Municipal Building Commission Chambers located at 290 South Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001, June 1, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. There will be a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting held at Preston Park, May 13, 2020, at 10:00 am.

Pennsylvania Prevailing wage rates will be required on this Contract.

Copies of Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at The Gateway Engineers, Inc.; 122 W. Brady Street, Butler, PA 16001 where sets of said documents may be obtained at a cost of \$50.00. Documents will be available beginning on May 4, 2020. An additional charge of \$10.00 is required for Contract Documents mailed to prospective bidders. No refund or exchange will be made for the return of any Documents.

A Notice to Proceed (NTP) will be delivered once the statewide work restriction has been lifted (non-essential work shutdown) by the Governor.

Performance and Labor Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Butler Township in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. The Township reserves the right to waive any bid informalities or to reject any or all bids.

If more time is necessary for the determination of the lowest responsible bidder, the Commission of Butler Township reserves the right to award the Contract later but not exceeding sixty (60) days from the date Bids were submitted. Such date will be publicly announced immediately after the bids are opened.
