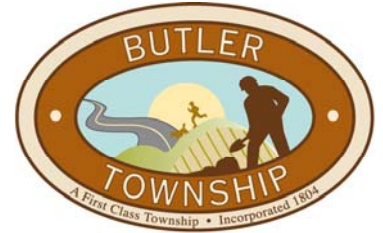


Emergency Services Monthly Report

Fire District Update

- 1.** The Fire District had two record months at the end of the Year. November there were 97 calls for service and in December there were 94 calls for service.
- 2.** The Fire District ordered and took delivery of CPR mannequins. They were purchased with the intent of getting members certified as CPR instructors to offer CPR classes to the community and have them available at Community events to teach proper “Hands Only” CPR.
- 3.** Over the Christmas holiday weekend, when there were prolonged periods of extreme cold and subzero windchill, the Fire District answered 30 calls for service. Additionally, the Board of Directors authorized additional funds for shifts to improve response times, and to handle the increased service demand.
- 4.** The Fire District held their annual Christmas Party following Township Commissioners meeting. Elected

officials and members of the fire district had an opportunity to socialize together.

- 5.** The Board of Directors has appointed a new Chairman and Co-Chairman. Jason Spink is the Chairman, and Dave Sanderson is the Co-Chairman.
- 6.** The Fire district will be publishing an annual report highlighting the accomplishments of the members and the organization. It should be completed by the end of next week.
