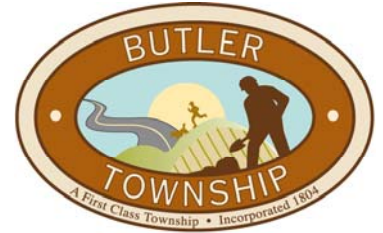

Fire District Update

- 3.** The Fire District had several members attend a First Responder Recognition Mass/Blessing in February.
- 4.** The Fire District has 6 members participating the Entry Level training program being run at BC3.

- The Director of Emergency Services participated in the monthly EMA training at Butler County Emergency Services.
- The Director is working to update the website with an “After the Fire” resources page to aid residents in navigating the requirements following a fire.
- The Director is working as part of the County Fire Chief’s association to work to educate county and local officials on the needs of the Fire Service. Additionally, the Director and members of the Fire District hold key positions in the Fire Chief’s association. We are looking to improve the Chief’s Association function to best meet the needs of the Fire Service.
