## Fire District Update

1. The Fire District conducted training at a residence on Longview Drive. Crews were able to practice hoseline advancements, laddering, search and rescue, and other fireground tactics.
2. We had seventeen members sign up to become CPR instructors and we are currently in the process of completing the necessary training.
3. The Fire District is hosting the first two modules of the Entry level program. BC3 is running those two modules at Cranberry, and we are running them concurrently so there was a different schedule in case others could not participate in the BC3 sponsored course. The Fire District has several members taking the entry level program.
4. The Fire District hosted the First Installation dinner since 2019 at the Lyndora American Legion.
